Join us in the fight to end homelessness! Did you know that on any given night, 748 people in Monroe County experience homelessness? Once the COVID-19 pandemic subsided, even more individuals and families struggled to find affordable housing due to increased costs of living. As the fair market rents (the cost to rent a moderately-priced unit in a local housing market) have increased (from \$1,050 to a projected \$1,149 for the Rochester, NY area), those living on fixed and limited incomes are struggling more than ever to save enough to afford the first month's rent and security deposit many property managers require in order for prospective tenants to secure a unit. In an effort to alleviate some of this burden in our community, Dimitri House has been running a program specifically targeted toward providing security deposits since 2015.

The DASH program (otherwise known as Dimitri Affordable Safe Housing) has helped provide security deposits for those in need who are also experiencing homelessness in the Rochester community. In an effort to ensure that clients remain housed, the DASH program requires case management with regular monthly contact so that there will be adequate support available should difficulties arise. Additionally, Dimitri House makes quarterly contact with participating landlords to confirm our clients' ongoing success or discuss options if they are struggling. Although some housing is short term, it often gives people the stability they needed to consider and enroll in a program for recovery for substance use and/or mental health disorders. Housing First is a key component of a successful path in recovery, employment, education, and building the bonds of family.

Since its inception in 2015, the DASH program has assisted 236 individuals and families in securing the housing that they needed. Half of the total participants in the program have been single parents which has allowed us to support families with children in obtaining the housing permanency necessary for increased success in school. Some participants in the DASH program have remained housed for up to eight years!

Dimitri House is a non-profit organization built upon the belief that every human being has immeasurable value, and our services are here to help them on their journey toward self-sufficiency. Often a client will express their gratitude for such assistance, knowing that without this assistance they may never have overcome homelessness (see upper right hand corner page 3 for a letter from a DASH participant.) At Dimitri House, we believe that everyone deserves a safe and secure place to call home.

We have been honored to receive a sizable grant yearly from the William G. Mc-Gowan Charitable Fund to support this program and, without them, we would not have been able to aid as many as we have in these past few years. Would you consider at least a \$100 donation to help give one more family the home they need and deserve? Times are tough for all of us, but together we can make a difference!
